**Lost and Found | 17 NOVEMBER 2019 | JOHN 9:35-41**

1. THINK ABOUT THE CONTEXT AND PUT YOURSELF IN THE STORY OF JOHN 9:35-41; IMAGINE IF YOU HAD BEEN BLIND SINCE BIRTH AND HAD BEEN HEALED, SUCH THAT YOU COULD SEE FOR THE FIRST TIME IN YOUR LIFE. WHAT WOULD THAT BE LIKE?

AND THEN IMAGINE THAT, JUST AFTER YOU ARE HEALED YOU ARE LEFT HANGING BY YOUR FAMILY, ARE INSULTED BY PEOPLE IN POWER AND KICKED OUT OF THE SYNAGOGUE. HOW WOULD YOU FEEL AFTER ALL THAT?

THE BLIND MAN MIGHT HAVE FELT ALONE AND ABANDONED AT THIS POINT. DO YOU STRUGGLE WITH FEELINGS OF LONELINESS OR ABANDONMENT? IF SO, HOW CAN YOU WORK THROUGH THOSE FEELINGS IN YOUR RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD?

2. IN JOHN 9:39 JESUS SAID, "FOR JUDGMENT I CAME INTO THIS WORLD," BUT HOW DO WE RECONCILE THAT WITH JOHN 3:17-18 AND JOHN 12:47?
3. ABOVE ALL, AFTER REVEALING TO THIS MAN THAT HE WAS THE MESSIAH, WHY MIGHT JESUS FOLLOW THAT REVELATION WITH THIS STATEMENT ABOUT JUDGEMENT?
